

Jesus told His disciples that five of the bridesmaids were wise and five were foolish. The five wise bridesmaids brought extra oil for their lamps so they wouldn't run out. The other five didn't.

The groom didn't show up right away, so everyone got tired and fell asleep. At midnight a messenger came and said the groom was ready! But, remember—five of the bridesmaids were foolish. On the way, their lamps started to burn out. They asked the others to share their oil, but the wise bridesmaids knew if they shared they wouldn't have enough for themselves. So the five foolish girls hurried to go buy more oil. While they were gone, the groom came and took everyone who was ready into the celebration. The others returned and tried to get in, but the door was closed. The foolish bridesmaids knocked. They cried out to the groom to let them in, but he wouldn't. It was too late.

Being ready means you love Jesus and live your life for Him.

So what does this story have to do with Jesus? Well, just like the groom, Jesus promised He would return, but we don't know when He's coming back. He promised to take everyone who believes in Him to Heaven to live with Him forever. He even said there would be a big celebration and a feast! But, He wants us to be ready because not everyone will get to come.
